Please note the following statement from the Council - *the Prime Minister is still of the mind that these elections will not take place, however legislation requiring the elections to go ahead has not yet been repealed. The government currently has until 22 May 2019 to get their withdrawal bill through the House of Commons and if successful could lead to a last minute cancellation of these elections.*
